**FILM SCRIPTS**

One can never make a good film from a bad script. But it is possible to make a bad film from a good script. So we can say that a good script is the base of a good film.

Starting with the theme, the scenario is developed and from synopsis the treatment is followed by screenplay to make the shooting script ready. With scenes - dialogues - shots camera movements and effects the final draft of a film script looks like an engineering plan of a big project.

Roger Manvell, a famous script writer once said "The future of the cinema rests on the invention and creativity of these people who create the stories and the characters for the film. Only good screenplays written by men of talent and imagination will keep the cinema in the forefront of the entertainment world.

The Director creates the film from the words of the script and directs the movements of the Actors and Camera.

Novels or stories are not written to make films; if they do they become screenplays rather than novels or stories. Likewise screenplays are not written for general reading - they are written only for film making.

In a novel or story, the idea of the writer may not reach the minds of the readers as it is. Readers can visualize the incidents on their own. But in a film the audience must feel as the director expects them to feel. Otherwise it is a failure. Dialogues in a film must have the feel of life like speech otherwise they give the impact of stage play or reading a book. If we close our

eyes in a cinema theatre the impact is different. You get the full expression of the scene only when you can see the feelings and gestures of the actors.

A lot of change is required to transform a novel or story into a film script. The director cannot shoot the pages of a novel or a story.

A novel or story writer can not write a film script without knowing the technique of film making, likewise a director or film script writer may not write a good novel or story without knowing the process or style of novel or story writing.

A novel writer can narrate a landscape in 5 or 6 pages but it is only one shot for a film maker.

As Jiddu Krishna Murthy has said "Developing a perfect technique does not make you a creator. You may know how to write a poem technically perfect - but you may not become a poet. Knowing a technique in different and creativity is different.

A script writer must know all the aspects of film making including technique and budget. Then only he can write perfect shooting script.

But what she finds is completely different from what she imagined. It's much worse: a school isolated on a high mountain plain, wild children, people she has nothing in common with and a hostile environment. She sticks it out because of pride and because Francesco loves her for her courage, until one cold February day when everything goes wrong, everything seems lost forever.
